About Kenneth

Leland will speak at several events planned throughout the day. A Marine squad leader who was wounded twice in Vietnam, he returned to the United States to become a police officer, and later a chief of police. He joined the Department of Agriculture before retiring and currently volunteers to speak about the Vietnam War and lessons learned from his tour of duty. He is a recipient of the George Washington Honor Medal from the Freedoms Foundation at Valley Forge. Leland will discuss his volunteer work as a speaker, bringing context to an important time in America's history and assist students and the community in better understanding how the nation and world we live in came to be.
